Development Update

Key Milestone: Formed as a separate committee to focus on capacity building

Main Goal: Grow membership to support PNJ's long-term stability and leadership pipeline

Focus Areas:

- Attract new & younger members
- Increase corporate sponsors & partners
- Engage more local HPCs

Recent Progress:

- Membership uptick during July Drive
- Built outreach databases (contractors, HPCs, schools, etc.)
- More tabling at PNJ events to recruit members

Financial Update

- **Fiscal year total revenue** - **\$115,797** (115.8 % versus budget)
- **Total expenses** - \$97,456 (110.1% versus budget)
- **Increase net assets** - Net assets increased by \$18,341 or 43.4 % over the previous year.
- **Months Operating Cash** - The cash balance of **\$60,581** provides for 7.5 months of operating cash based on actual FY 2025 expenses.

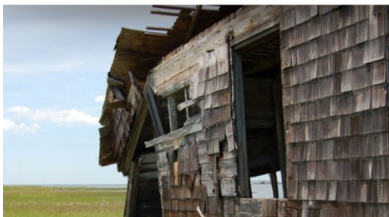
